

Recruitment on Contract Basis for Providing Employment Opportunities in the Technological Service (Civil) to Fulfill the Additional Staff Required for the Restoration of the Damages Caused Within the Central Province due to the Ditwah Disaster Situation – 2026

Applications are hereby invited island-wide for 50 contract-basis positions in the Technological Service (Civil), to recruit temporary staff required for the restoration of the damages caused to the physical resources maintained by institutions under the central provincial council due to the Ditwah disaster situation. (as 20 for the Central Provincial Department of Engineering Services, 10 for the Central Provincial Department of Irrigation, and 20 for the Central Provincial Department of Local Government)

The closing date of the application is **31.07.2026**.

01. General conditions

- 1.1 Shall be a citizen of Sri Lanka
- 1.2 Applicants shall be not less than 21 years and not more than 30 years of age on the closing date of applications (accordingly, only those who were born on or before 31.07.2005 or born on or after 31.07.1996 are eligible to apply for this post)
- 1.3 Should possess the adequate physical and mental fitness required to serve in any area of Central Province and discharge duties of the post
- 1.4 Applicants residing any part of the Island shall apply.
- 1.5 No person who is ordained in any religious order shall become eligible to sit the examination
- 1.6 Shall have completed all the qualifications and conditions prescribed in the notification as at the date mentioned in the recruitment notification

04. Recruitment procedure

- 4.1. Recruitment for these posts shall be made on a contractual basis. Where the number of applications received is less than the number of vacancies, selection will be conducted via an interview to verify qualifications. In the event that the number of applications exceeds the available vacancies, selection shall be based on a structured interview.

05. Service Conditions

- 5.1. This recruitment shall be carried out on a contract basis solely to secure the additional staff required for the programs initiated to restore the damages caused within the Central Province due to the Ditwah disaster situation.
- 5.2. Recruitment shall be made on a contract basis only for a period up to **31.12.2026**. The Central Province Public Service Commission reserves the right to terminate this contract assignment at any given time as required.
- 5.3. It should not be assumed that all those who apply for this will be necessarily appointed to the service on a contractual basis.

06. Salary scale

In terms of Schedule II of the Public Administration Circular No. 10/2025 dated 25.03.2025, a monthly payment of Rs. 52,250/-, which is the initial salary step of the MN-3-2025 salary scale applicable to Grade III of the Technological Officer post, shall be paid. However, payments shall be made in accordance with the provisions of in Schedule III said circular. The cost of living allowance will be paid in addition to your contract allowance.

07. Duly perfected applications should be posted under registered cover so as to reach “**Secretary, Central Provincial Public Service Commission, No. 244, Katugastota Road, Kandy**” on or before **31.07.2026**. The caption of “**Recruitment on Contract Basis for Providing Employment Opportunities in the Technological Service (Civil) to Fulfill the Additional Staff Required for the Restoration of the Damages Caused Within the Central Province due to the Ditwah Disaster Situation – 2026**” should be indicated on the top left hand corner of the envelope enclosing the application. Applications received after the closing date of applications and incomplete application will be rejected without any notice. No complaint will be entertained in relation to the loss of applications or documents in post or delays in delivery.
08. The Central Province Public Service Commission reserves the right to make decisions regarding any matter covered or not covered by this notification, as well as the final decision regarding the number of personnel to be appointed on a contract basis. Furthermore, if there is any matter for which provisions have not been made in this notification, the power to clarify and make a decision on such matters rests with the Central Province Public Service Commission.
09. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala, Tamil and English text of this notification, the Sinhala text shall prevail as the accurate text.
